

- **a.** The Annual Congregation Meeting is scheduled for Sunday, January 30, 2022, following Church Service. This will be an in-church and simultaneous virtual (GPC website, FB, or YouTube) congregational meeting. A meeting Information Packet will be prepared with instructions for advance ballot mail-in for only those who receive a printed Newsletter. Packets will also be sent via email to all congregants with an email address; advance packets will be available in the Narthex two weeks prior to our meeting. SEE YOU THERE!!!
- **b.** The Information Packet will contain the following documents: Annual Meeting Agenda, GPC Annual Reports Packet, 2022 Operating Budget Summary for 2021 and Proposed Budget for 2022, Minutes from the last Annual Meeting on January 31, 2021, and Ballot for 2022 Annual Meeting.

- **c.** There will be 5 items to be voted upon during the Annual Meeting:
- In accordance with our By-Laws, we will be voting to elect Rev. Dr. Douglas Cederberg as our Settled Pastor,
- 2). Electing three (3) GB members to replace the expiring term of 3 existing members,
- 3). Approving the Operating Budget for 2022 contained in the Annual Report,
- 4). Approving the Minutes from the January 31, 2021, Annual Meeting,
- 5). Approving The Way Forward Mission Implementation Operating Concept.
- **d.** Our Annual Report (2021) is prepared. THANKS to all Church Teams that submitted their 2021 Annual Report Input to the Church Office as requested. Excellent preparation by Karen Allen and Carolina Mata to produce a "first-class" report.
- **e.** The recent Governing Board meeting discussed the following:
